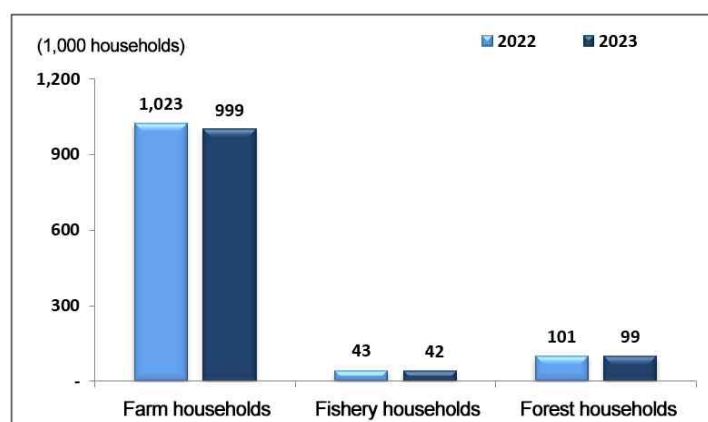
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Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery Survey in 2023

Farm, Forest and Fishery Household and Population

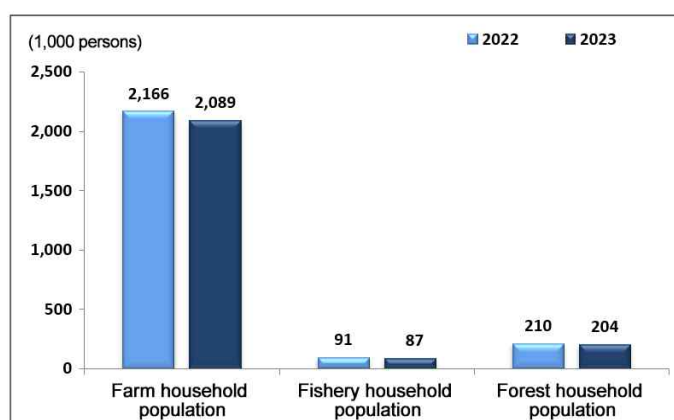
In 2023, the number of farm households was 999 thousand. The number of fishery households was 42 thousand. The number of forest households was 99 thousand.

- As of December 1, 2023, the number of farm households was 999 thousand. The number of fishery households (excluding inland waters fisheries) was 42 thousand. The number of forest households was 99 thousand.
- Compared to 2022, the number of farm, fishery and forest households fell by 2.3%, 1.8% and 1.4%, respectively.



Size of farm, fishery and forest households (2022-2023)

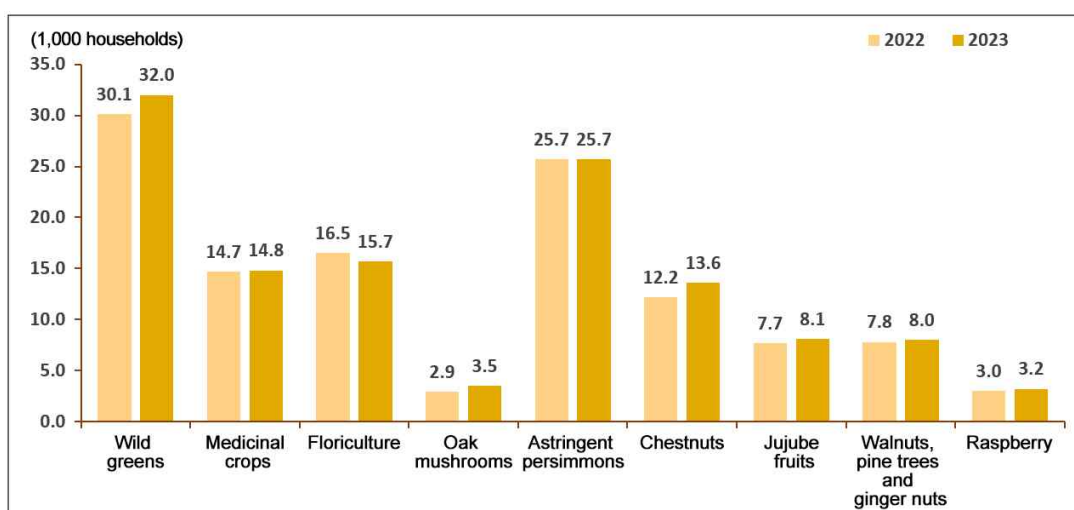
- The farm household population was 2.089 million persons. The fishery household population (excluding inland waters fisheries) was 87 thousand persons. The forest household population was 204 thousand persons.
- Compared to 2022, the farm, fishery and forest household population fell by 3.5%, 4.1% and 2.7%, respectively.



Size of farm, fishery and forest household population (2022-2023)

As for growing products, 'Wild greens' recorded the highest share, which was followed by 'Astringent persimmons' and 'Floriculture'.

- Forest households growing forest products amounted to 94 thousand households, which declined by 0.9% from 2022.
- As for forest households by growing item, households growing wild greens recorded the highest figure of 32 thousand households, which was followed by those growing astringent persimmons (26 thousand households) and those growing floriculture (16 thousand households).
