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Final Results of the Cultivated Area and Production of Autumn Cabbages, Autumn Radishes, Beans, Apples and Pears in 2025

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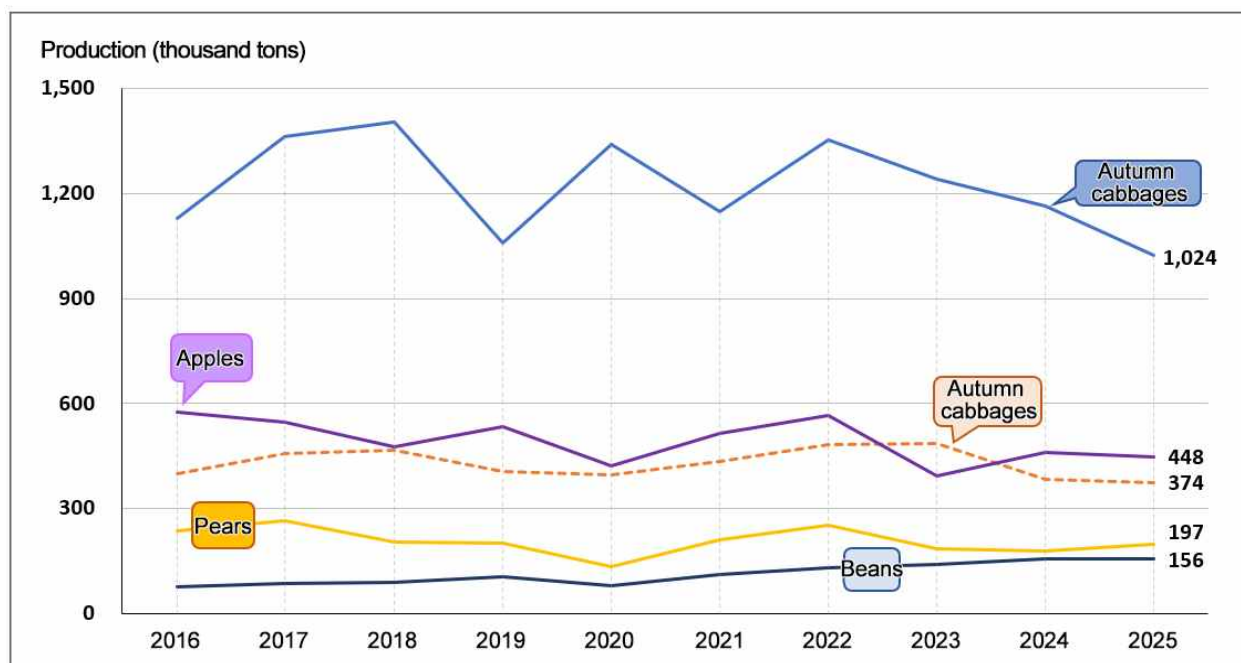
Final Results of the Cultivated Area and Production of Autumn Cabbages, Autumn Radishes, Beans, Apples and Pears in 2025

- The production of autumn cabbages fell by 12.0% from 1.164 million tons in 2024 to 1.024 million tons in 2025.
- The production of autumn radishes dropped by 2.7% from 384 thousand tons in 2024 to 374 thousand tons in 2025.
- The production of beans grew by 0.8% from 155 thousand tons in 2024 to 156 thousand tons in 2025.
- The production of apples declined by 2.6% from 460 thousand tons in 2024 to 448 thousand tons in 2025.
- The production of pears increased by 10.7% from 178 thousand tons in 2024 to 197 thousand tons in 2025.

1. Production of autumn cabbages and autumn radishes

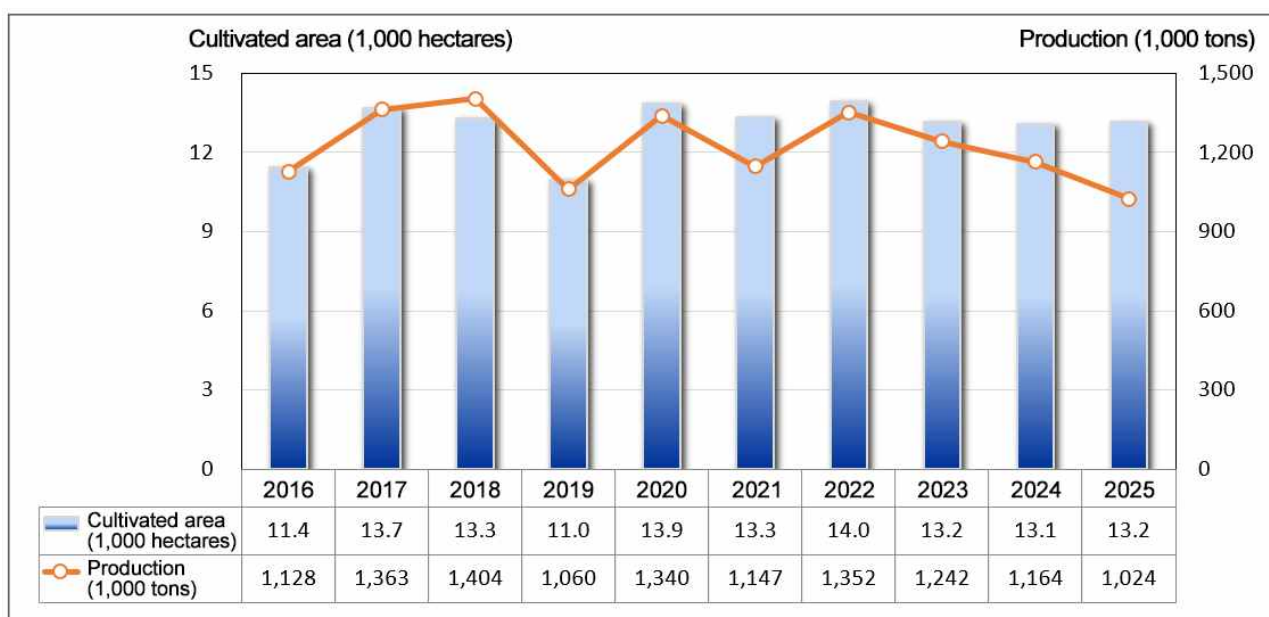
(1) Production of autumn cabbages

- The production of autumn cabbages fell by 140 thousand tons ($\triangle 12.0\%$) from 1.164 million tons in 2024 to 1.024 million tons in 2025.

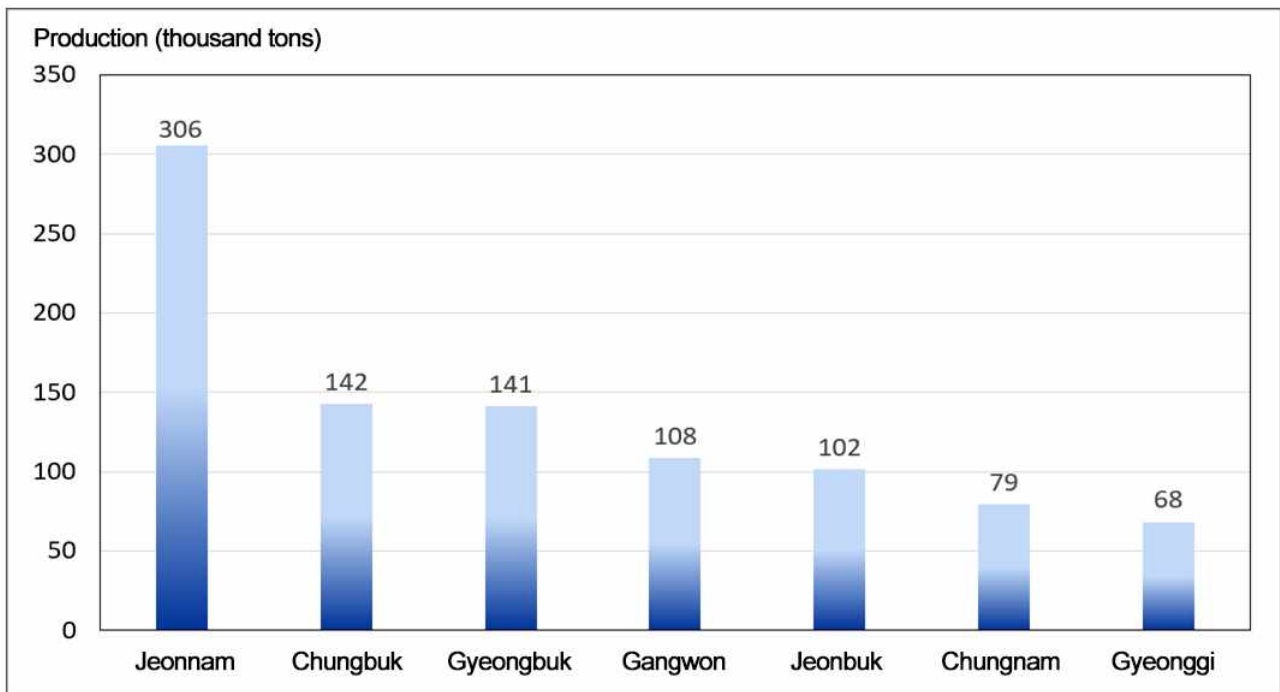

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of autumn cabbages by year >

- The cultivated area of autumn cabbages grew by 105ha (0.8%) from 13,076ha in 2024 to 13,182ha in 2025.
- The production per 10a dropped by 1,134kg ($\triangle 12.7\%$) from 8,902kg in 2024 to 7,768kg in 2025.
- As for autumn cabbage production by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 306 thousand tons, which was followed by Chungbuk (142 thousand tons) and Gyeongbuk (141 thousand tons).

(2) Production of autumn radishes

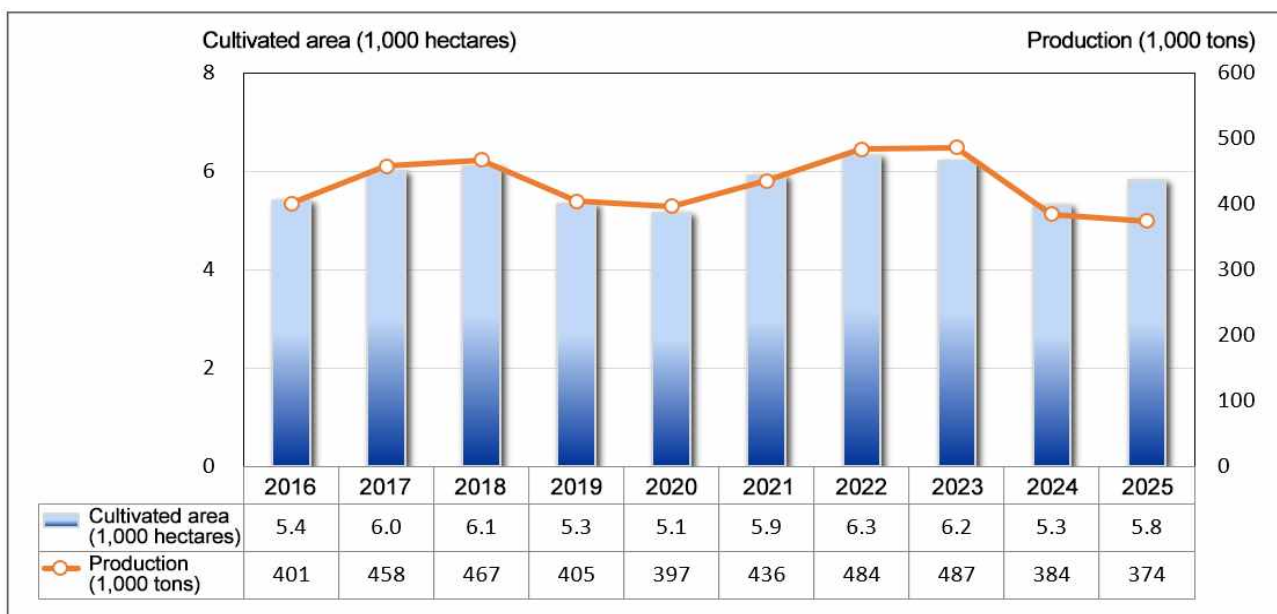
- The production of autumn radishes dropped by 10 thousand tons ($\triangle 2.7\%$) from 384 thousand tons in 2024 to 374 thousand tons in 2025.

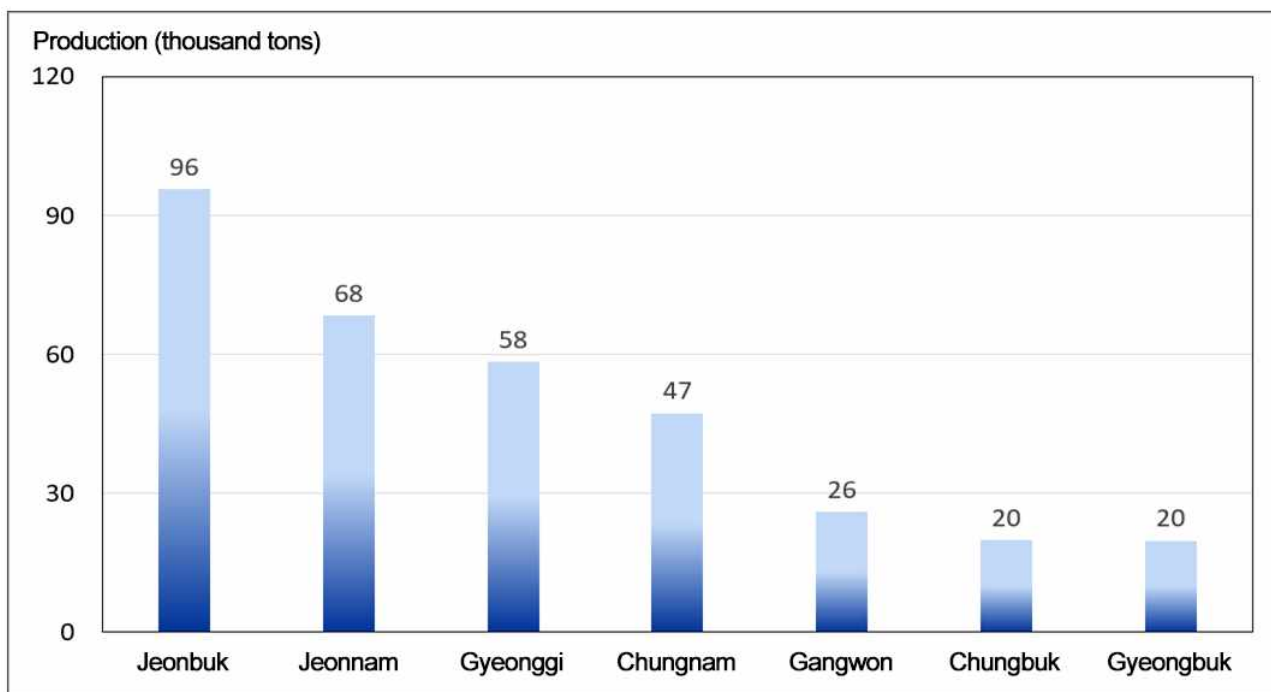

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of autumn radishes by year >

- ☐ The cultivated area of autumn radishes grew by 519ha (9.8%) from 5,308ha in 2024 to 5,826ha in 2025.
- ☐ The production per 10a dropped by 820kg ($\triangle$ 11.3%) from 7,243kg in 2024 to 6,423kg in 2025.
- ☐ As for autumn radish production by province, Jeonbuk recorded the highest figure of 96 thousand tons, which was followed by Jeonnam (68 thousand tons) and Gyeonggi (58 thousand tons).



< Autumn radish production of top 7 provinces >

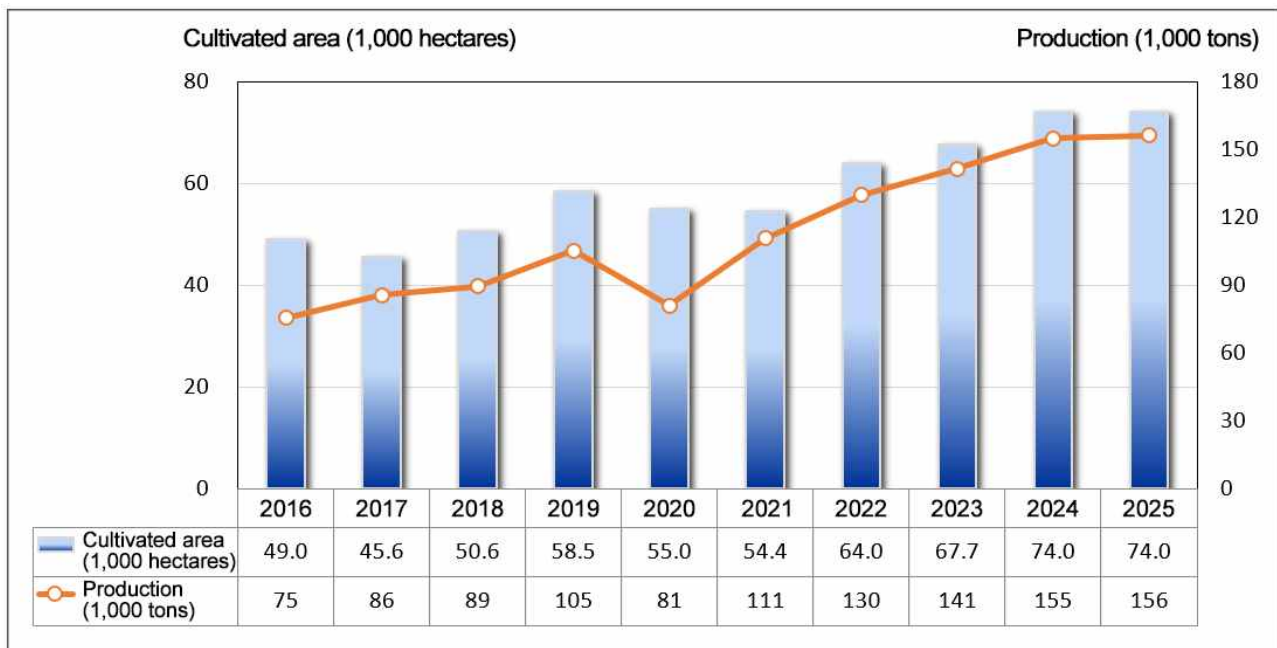
2. Production of beans

- ☐ The production of beans grew by 1 thousand tons (0.8%) from 155 thousand tons in 2024 to 156 thousand tons in 2025.

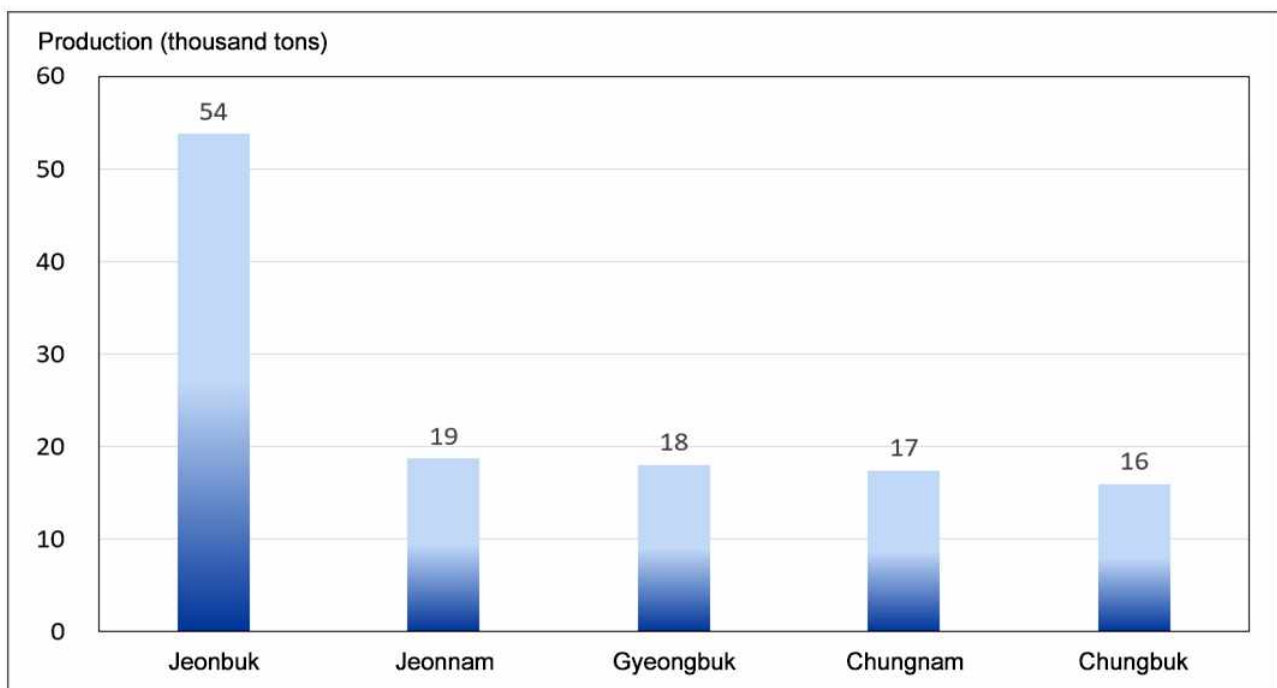

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of beans by year >

- ☐ The cultivated area of beans slightly dropped by 3ha ($\triangle 0.0\%$) from 74,018ha in 2024 to 74,015ha in 2025.
- ☐ The production per 10a grew by 2kg (0.8%) from 209kg in 2024 to 211kg in 2025.
- ☐ As for bean production by province, Jeonbuk recorded the highest figure of 54 thousand tons, which was followed by Jeonnam (19 thousand tons) and Gyeongbuk (18 thousand tons).

3. Production of apples and pears

(1) Production of apples

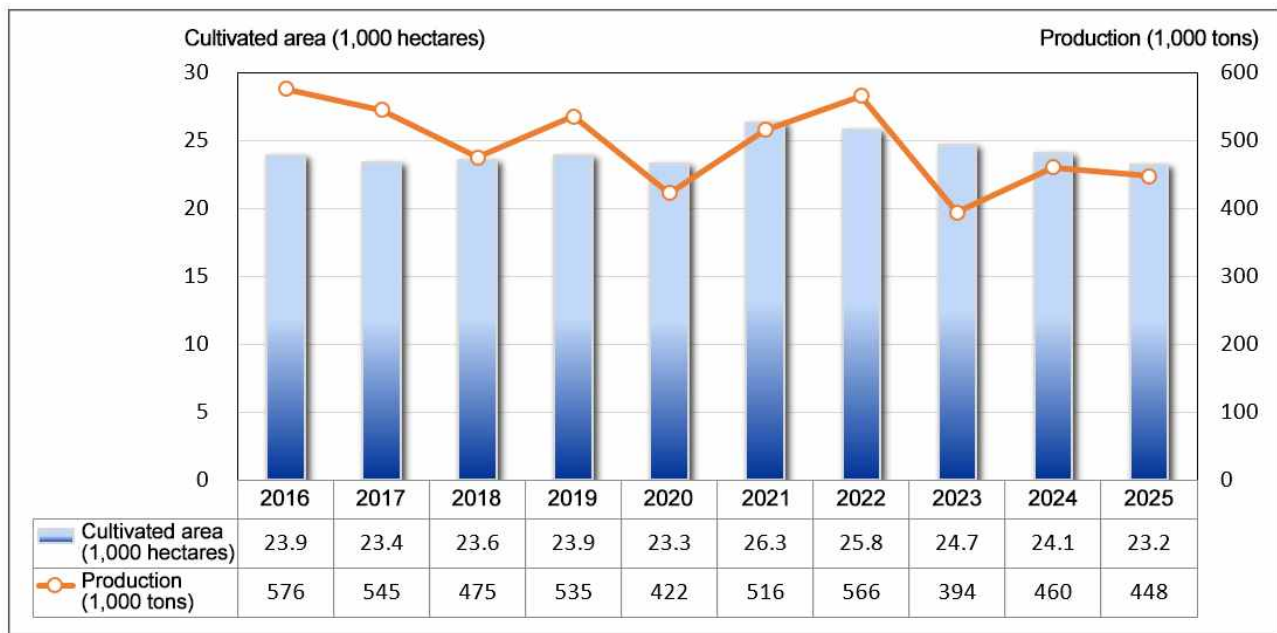
- The production of apples declined by 12 thousand tons ($\triangle 2.6\%$) from 460 thousand tons in 2024 to 448 thousand tons in 2025.

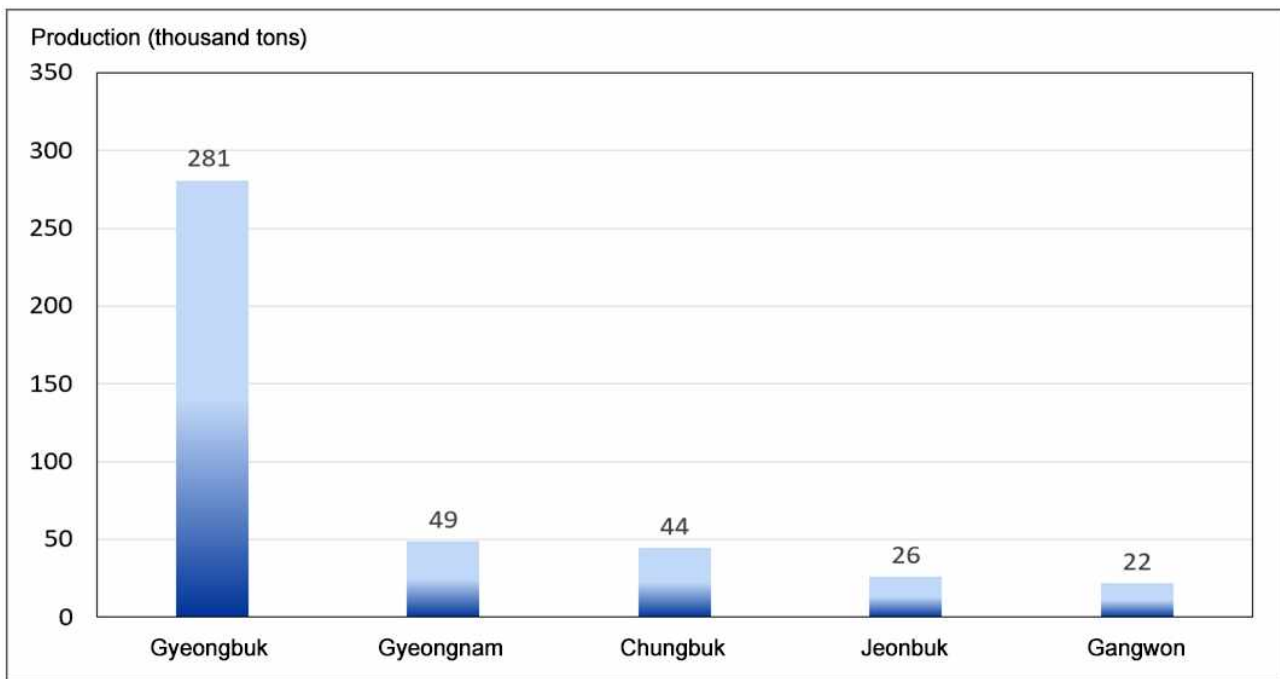

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of apples by year >

- The cultivated area of apples (based on ripe fruits) declined by 887ha ($\triangle 3.7\%$) from 24,066ha in 2024 to 23,180ha in 2025.
- The production per 10a grew by 21kg (1.1%) from 1,912kg in 2024 to 1,933kg in 2025.
- As for apple production by province, Gyeongbuk recorded the highest figure of 281 thousand tons, which was followed by Gyeongnam (49 thousand tons) and Chungbuk (44 thousand tons).

(2) Production of pears

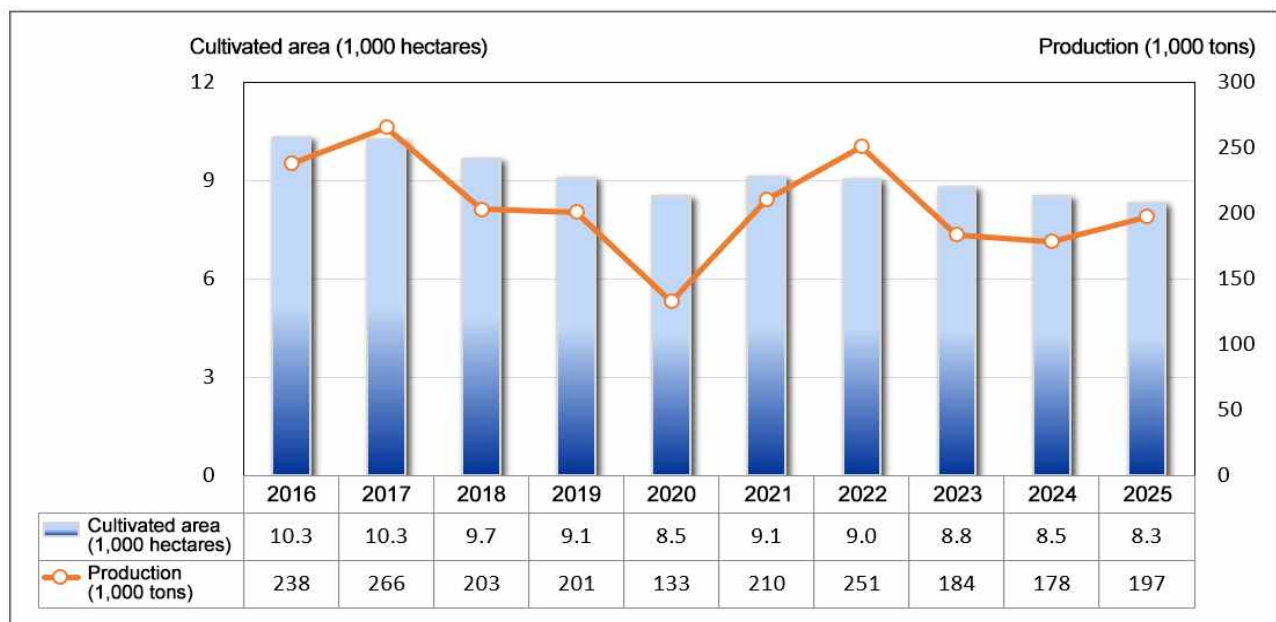
- The production of pears rose by 19 thousand tons (10.7%) from 178 thousand tons in 2024 to 197 thousand tons in 2025.

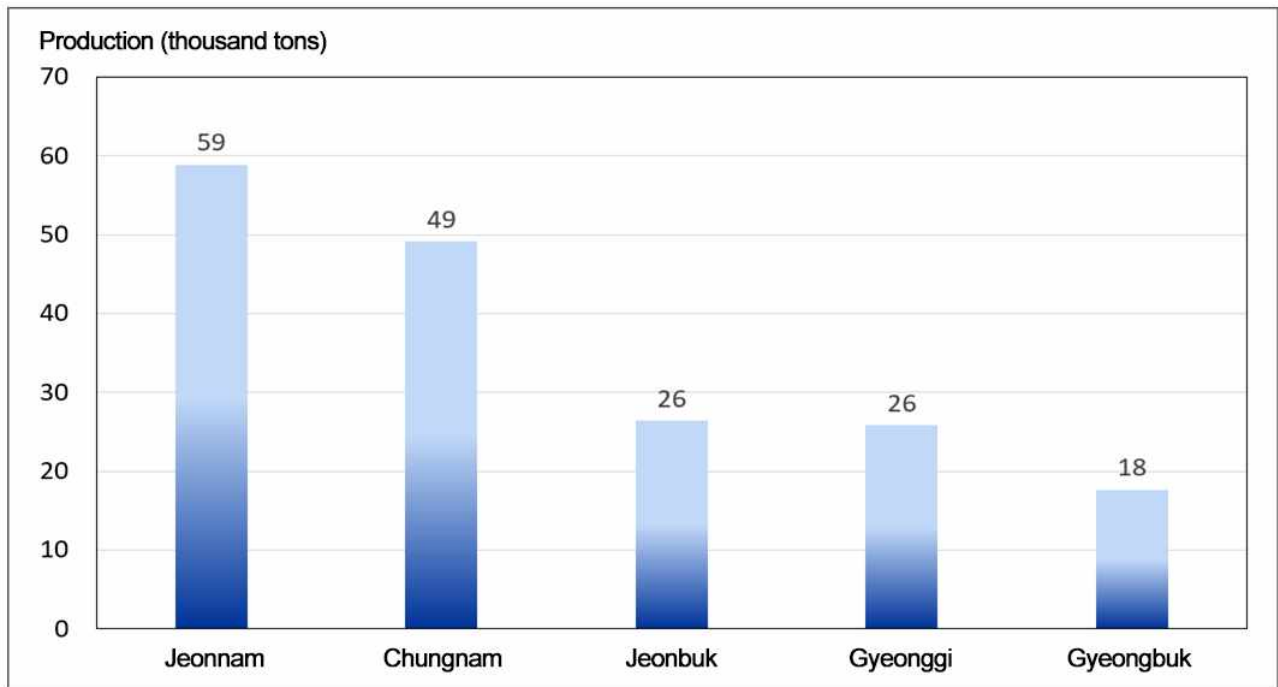

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of pears by year >

- ☐ The cultivated area of pears (based on ripe fruits) declined by 207ha ($\triangle 2.4\%$) from 8,529ha in 2024 to 8,322ha in 2025.
- ☐ The production per 10a grew by 281kg (13.4%) from 2,092kg in 2024 to 2,373kg in 2025.
- ☐ As for pear production by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 59 thousand tons, which was followed by Chungnam (49 thousand tons) and Jeonbuk (26 thousand tons).
