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Results of the Farm and Fishery Household Economy Survey in 2025

I . Farm household economy

- ☐ In 2025, the average farm household income* recorded 54.667 million won, which increased by 4.071 million won (8.0%) from 2024.

* Average farm household income

= Farm income + Non-farm income + Transfer income + Irregular income

- ☐ **(Farm income)**

The farm income marked 11.707 million won, rising by 2.131 million won (22.3%) from 2024.

- Compared to the previous year, gross farm receipts and farm expenses rose by 8.3% and 3.4%, respectively.

- ☐ **(Non-farm income)**

The non-farm income marked 19.639 million won, falling by 508 thousand won (-2.5%) from 2024.

- Compared to the previous year, non-farm business income rose by 0.5%, while non-business income fell by 4.0%.

- ☐ **(Transfer income)**

The transfer income was 19.895 million won, which increased by 1.655 million won (9.1%) from 2024.

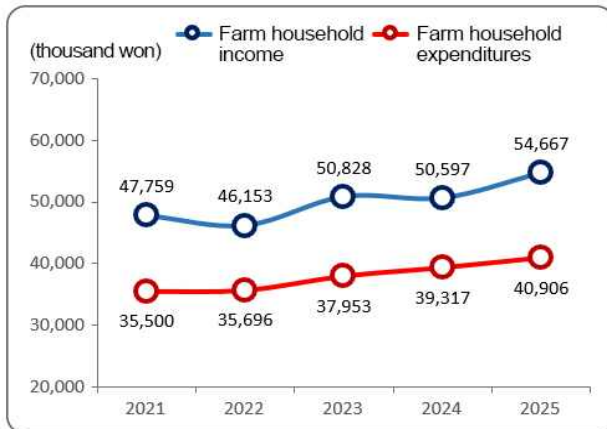
- Compared to the previous year, public and private subsidies grew by 9.3% and 5.1%, respectively.

- ☐ **(Irregular income)**

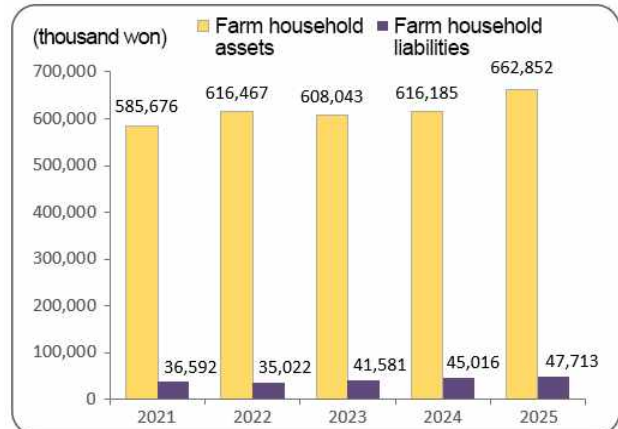
The irregular income stood at 3.427 million won, which rose by 793 thousand won (30.1%) from 2024.

- ☐ The farm household expenditures marked 40.906 million won, rising by 1.588 million won (4.0%) from the previous year.
- ☐ At the end of 2025, the average farm household assets recorded 662.852 million won, rising by 46.667 million won (7.6%) from the previous year.
- ☐ At the end of 2025, the average farm household liabilities recorded 47.713 million won, rising by 2.697 million won (6.0%) from the previous year.

II. Fishery household economy

- ☐ In 2025, the average fishery household income* marked 58.980 million won, which fell by 4.673 million won (-7.3%) from 2024.

* Average fishery household income

= Fishery income + Non-fishery income + Transfer income + Irregular income

- ☐ **(Fishery income)**

The fishery income marked 19.061 million won, falling by 8.824 million won (-31.6%) from 2024.

- Compared to the previous year, gross fishery receipts and fishery expenses fell by 13.3% and 4.7%, respectively.

- ☐ **(Non-fishery income)**

The non-fishery income stood at 17.236 million won, rising by 1.874 million won (12.2%) from 2024.

- Compared to the previous year, non-fishery business income and non-business income grew by 19.5% and 6.6%, respectively.

- ☐ **(Transfer income)**

The transfer income was 20.047 million won, which increased by 2.481 million won (14.1%) from 2024.

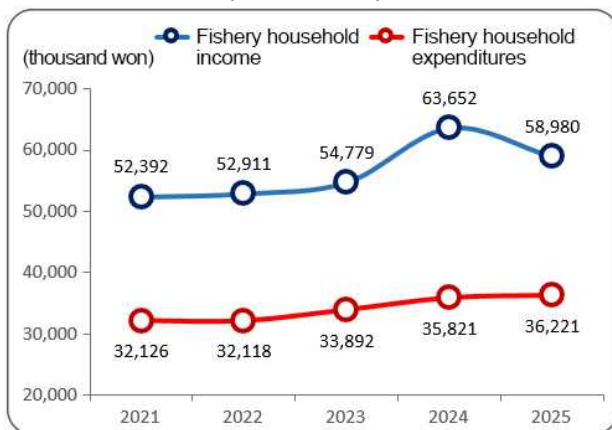
- Compared to the previous year, public and private subsidies grew by 14.3% and 6.4%, respectively.

- ☐ **(Irregular income)**

The irregular income stood at 2.635 million won, which dropped by 204 thousand won (-7.2%) from 2024.

- The fishery household expenditures marked 36.221 million won, rising by 400 thousand won (1.1%) from 2024.
- At the end of 2025, the average fishery household assets recorded 547.762 million won, rising by 13.893 million won (2.6%) from the previous year.
- At the end of 2025, the average fishery household liabilities recorded 70.761 million won, falling by 65 thousand won (-0.1%) from the previous year.
