

Characteristics of the Employed Persons by Industry and Occupation according to the Local Area Labour Force Survey in the First Half of 2017

Regions recording a high employment-population ratio showed a high share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing'.

- As for the share of employed persons in top five cities (Seogwipo-si, Dangjin-si, Naju-si, Jeju-si and Yeongcheon-si) of 9 provinces recording the highest employment-population ratios by industry and occupation,
 - Naju-si and Yeongcheon-si showed the highest shares of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' at 38.7 percent and 34.5 percent, respectively. Seogwipo-si, Dangjin-si and Jeju-si showed the highest shares of employed persons in 'Business, personal and public services' at 30.4 percent, 26.2 percent and 36.3 percent, respectively.
 - * All these five cities showed a higher share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' than all cities (7.1 percent).
 - Seogwipo-si, Naju-si and Yeongcheon-si showed the highest shares of 'Skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers' at 26.1 percent, 37.4 percent and 33.4 percent, respectively. Dangjin-si showed the highest share of 'Craft, machine operating and assembling workers' at 31.9 percent. Jeju-si showed the highest share of 'Service and sales workers' at 26.4 percent.
 - * All these five cities showed a lower share of 'Managers, professionals and related workers' than all cities (20.6 percent).
- As for the share of employed persons in top five regions (Ulleung-gun, Sinan-gun, Jangsu-gun, Cheongdo-gun and Inje-gun) recording the highest employment-population ratios by industry and occupation,
 - Ulleung-gun and Inje-gun showed the highest shares of employed persons in 'Business, personal and public services' at 41.0 percent and 35.1 percent, respectively. Sinan-gun, Jangsu-gun and Cheongdo-gun showed the highest shares of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' at 72.8 percent, 54.0 percent and 59.8 percent, respectively.
 - Ulleung-gun showed the highest share of 'Service and sales workers' at 23.0 percent. Sinan-gun, Jangsu-gun, Cheongdo-gun and Inje-gun showed the highest shares of 'Skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers' at 70.4 percent, 51.8 percent, 56.9 percent and 25.9 percent, respectively.

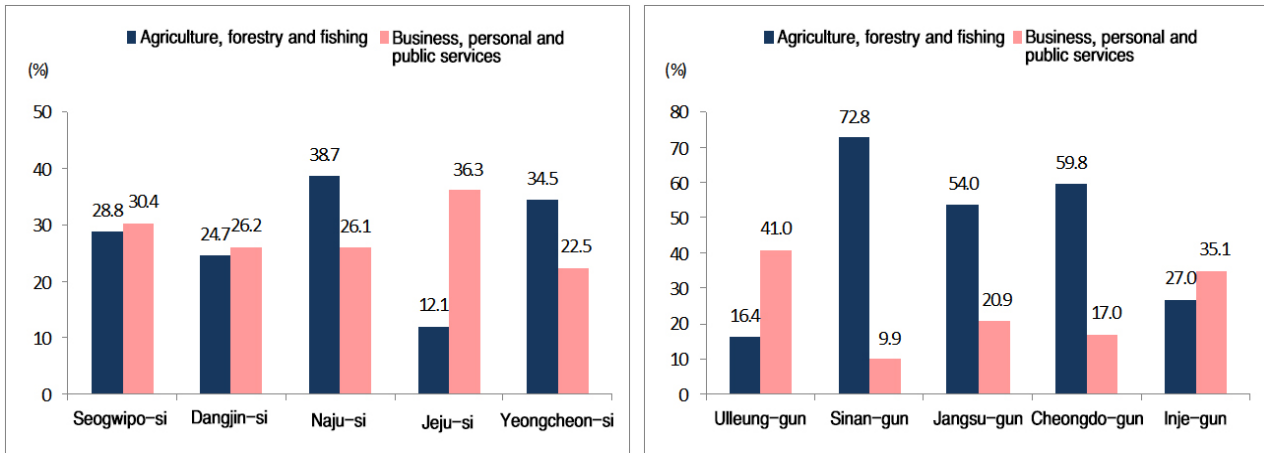

Sinan-gun recorded the highest share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing'. Geoje-si recorded the highest share of employed persons in 'Mining and manufacturing'. Uljin-gun recorded the highest share of employed persons in 'Construction'.

- As for the share of employed persons by industry, Sinan-gun marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' at 72.8 percent. Geoje-si marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Mining and Manufacturing' at 46.3 percent. Uljin-gun marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Construction' at 16.2 percent.
- Cities and Gun regions recording a high share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' and 'Mining and manufacturing' showed a higher employment-population ratio than the total cities (59.2%) and the total Gun regions (66.5%).
- * 5 cities and Gun regions recording a high share of employed persons in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' (employment-population ratio): Sinan-gun (75.1%), Jindo-gun (70.8%), Uiseong-gun (72.5%), Cheongdo-gun (73.6%), Gunwi-gun (72.5%),
- * 5 cities and Gun regions recording a high share of employed persons in 'Mining and manufacturing' (employment-population ratio): Geoje-si (62.4%), Siheung-si (59.9%), Gumi-si (59.5%), Eumseong-gun (69.4%), Osan-si (60.9%)
- Guri-si marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Wholesale and retail trade & accommodation and food service activities' at 31.0 percent. Seongnam-si marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Electricity, transportation, communications and financial activities' at 17.4 percent. Gwacheon-si marked the highest share of employed persons in 'Business, personal and public services' at 52.8 percent.

Gwacheon-si showed the highest shares of 'Managers & professionals and related workers' and 'Clerks'.

- As for the share of employed persons by occupation, Gwacheon-si showed the highest shares of 'Managers & professionals and related workers' (45.8%) and 'Clerks' (26.8%).

- Cities recording a high share of 'Managers & professionals and related workers' and 'Clerks' tended to show a relatively lower employment-population ratio compared to the employment-population ratio for all cities (59.2%).
- * 5 cities recording a high share of 'Managers & professionals and related workers' (employment-population ratio): Gwacheon-si (54.8%), Yongin-si (56.0%), Suwon-si (58.0%), Uiwang-si (56.9%), Seongnam-si (58.2%)
- * 5 cities recording a high share of 'Clerks' (employment-population ratio): Gwacheon-si (54.8%), Gunpo-si (58.2%), Yongin-si (56.0%), Anyang-si (60.0%), Uiwang-si (56.9%)
- Sokcho-si showed the highest share of 'Service and sales workers' at 31.0 percent. Sinan-gun showed the highest share of 'Skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers' at 70.4 percent. Siheung-si showed the highest share of 'Craft, machine operating & assembling workers' at 40.0 percent. Ulleung-gun showed the highest share of 'Elementary workers' at 21.3 percent.

The share of wage and salary workers earning an average of 2 million won or more per month went up by 2.8%p from the first half of 2016.

- Wage and salary workers amounted to 19,779 thousand persons.
 - The wage and salary workers earning 'less than 1 million won' and '1 million won ~ less than 2 million won' occupied 10.4 percent and 32.6 percent, respectively. The wage and salary workers earning '2 million won ~ less than 3 million won', '3 million won ~ less than 4 million won' and '4 million won or more' occupied 27.3 percent, 14.9 percent and 14.8 percent, respectively.
 - * The share of wage and salary workers earning 'less than 1 million won' and '1 million won ~ less than 2 million won' went down by 0.8%p and 2.0%p, respectively, compared to the first half of 2016. The share of wage and salary workers earning '2 million won or more' recorded 57.0 percent, which went up by 2.8%p compared to the first half of 2016.
